


STEP 6

- Enter a "RULE NAME" i.e Rule ON with Nest.
- Select "Nest Trigger"
- Select "Nest Structure"
- Tap "Continue"

CONNECT WITH NEST

STEP 7

- Tap on “(+) Add Device.”
- Select Device (i.e. Living Room Light).
- Time Restriction switch OFF.
 - If OFF, there will be no time restriction for this rule.
 - If ON, you may set a time frame for the rule to be applicable.
- Tap “Done.”

STEP 8

- Make sure the Device switch is to the ON position.
- Select Nest Trigger Type “Home.”
- Tap “Done.”




