





Step by Step Guide to connect with NEST



STEP 1 Open iHome Control App.








- Scroll down to THIRD-PARTY CONNECTION header.
- Select

 "Connect with Nest."





Tap the "Continue" button.





- Tap Sign in.






STEP 5

- Open the iHome Control App.
- Tap "Add a Rule"










- Enter a

 "RULE NAME" i.e


 Rule ON with Nest.
- Select "Nest Trigger"
- Select "Nest Structure"
- Tap "Continue"






- Tap on "(+) Add
- Select Device (i.e. Living Room Light).
- Time Restriction switch OFF.
 - · If OFF, there will be no time restriction for this
 - · If ON, you may set a time frame for the rule to be applicable.
- Tap "Done."





- Make sure the Device swich is to the ON position.
- Select Nest Trigger Type "Home."
- Tap "Done."






STEP 9

STEP 10


Select "Home" and the plug will turn ON.



STEP 11
To set a "Rule" to
turn OFF the
Smartplug(s) when
selecting "Away."


- Follow steps 1–5
- In step 6, enter a "RULE NAME" i.e Rule OFF with Nest





- Proceed to step 8;
 Make sure the
 DEVICE switch is to
 the OFF position
- Select Nest Trigger
 Type "Away."
- Tap "Done."





- Open your Nest App.
- Select "Away" and the plug will turn OFF.
